FOREWORD

The National Park Service, a bureau of the Department of the Interior, administers Federally owned scenic, scientific, historic, and recreational areas established by statutory authority for the benefit and enjoyment of the people, and the National Capital Parks, a metropolitan park system comprising over 750 urban and rural parks located in and around Washington, D. C. exclusive of the National Memorials located therein.

This monthly report contains data reflecting total use by the public of the national parks. Data are in thousands of visits. Statistically, a "Visit" is the entry of any person into a national park such that he makes some use of the services or facilities provided by the National Park Service. "Overnight stays" include park visitors in campgrounds and in commercial accommodations within the parks. A few parks are excluded from the reporting system for reasons of impracticality in producing consistent or meaningful data.
