Introduction

In 2012 the national parks received nearly 283 million recreation visits, demonstrating strong public support for the parks. By documenting these visits across the National Park System, the National Park Service (NPS) Statistical Abstract offers a historical record of public use in NPS units and provides NPS staff and partners with a useful tool for effective management and planning.

Public use records date back more than a century to 1904, when the national park idea was still new. In that first year (published in 1968 in *Public Use of the National Parks: A Statistical Report, 1904–1940*), six national parks reported their visitation, for a total of 140,954 visitors. By 1965, when the first annual abstract was produced, 199 NPS units reported a total of 121,312,000 visits. In 2012 those figures grew to 374 units reporting 282,765,682 recreation visits.

The responsibility for compiling visitation records lies with the Public Use Statistics Office, part of the Social Science Branch of the Natural Resource Stewardship and Science Directorate's Environmental Quality Division. In addition to the Statistical Abstract, the Public Use Statistics Office produces monthly visitation summaries and in-depth analyses examining changes in visitation over the decades, current trends in park visitation, and short-term visitation forecasts. These reports are available on the Public Use Statistics website at <https://irma.nps.gov/Stats>. Additional reports prepared by the Social Science Branch (www.nature.nps.gov/socialscience) supplement public use information by exploring the attitudes, behaviors, and economic impacts of visitors and visitor use in parks.

The Public Use Statistics Office relies on the conscientious efforts of NPS field staff to count, record, and report public use. A program of collecting and analyzing monthly public use data is combined with continuous auditing of park counting procedures to ensure consistency and accuracy of data. (In 2012, 374 of 398 NPS units collected public use data; the remainder are unable to do so for a variety of reasons, such as joint administration, staffing issues, and nonfederal land ownership. Detailed, unit-specific instructions for the units that collect data are available on the Public Use Statistics website.) The Public Use Statistics Office compiles and summarizes the monthly data to produce the annual Statistical Abstract.

2012 Public Use Data

Recreation visits form the core of the public use statistics effort in national parks. They are defined as “the entry of a person onto lands or waters administered by the NPS for recreational purposes, excluding government personnel, through traffic (commuters), tradespeople, and people residing within park boundaries.” The following tables and figures record the number of recreation visits to NPS units in 2012; some tables compare those figures to 2011 visitation. Endnotes that apply to multiple tables and definitions for terms and abbreviations used in the tables can be found in the appendixes.

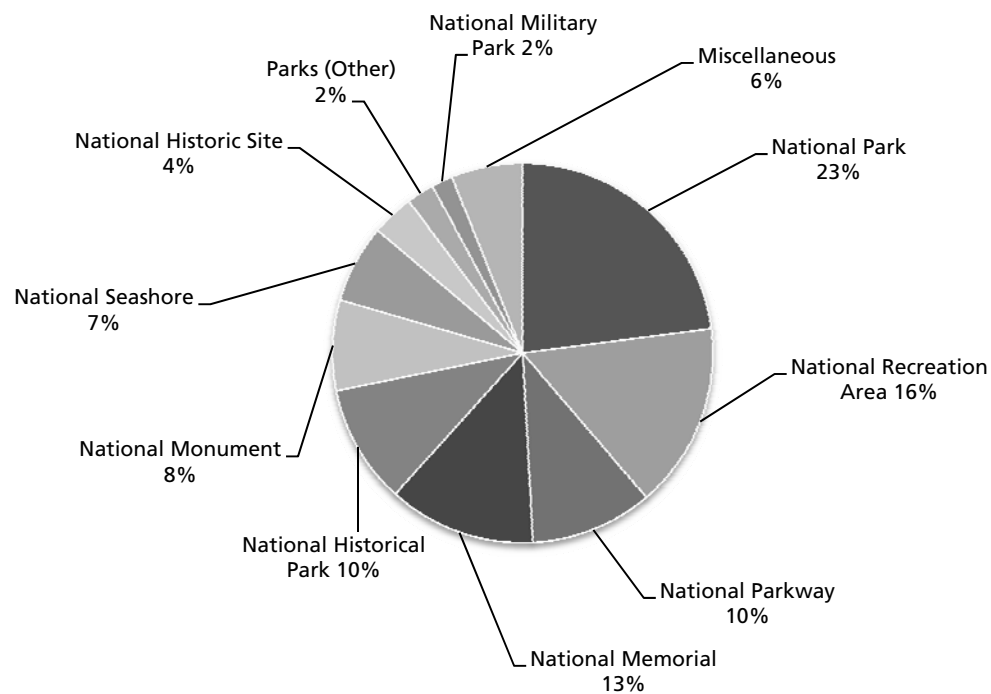
Recreation Visits by Type of Unit

Table 1 includes the number of recreation visits by type of unit in 2012; Figure 1 is a graphic representation of the same data. Of the 398 NPS units in 2012, 374 reported public use statistics (see Table 7 for a list of units that do not report public use data). National parks received the highest percentage of recreation visits (23 percent), followed by national recreation areas (16 percent) and national memorials (13 percent). Some unit types with positive recreation visits show 0 percent of total visits due to rounding.

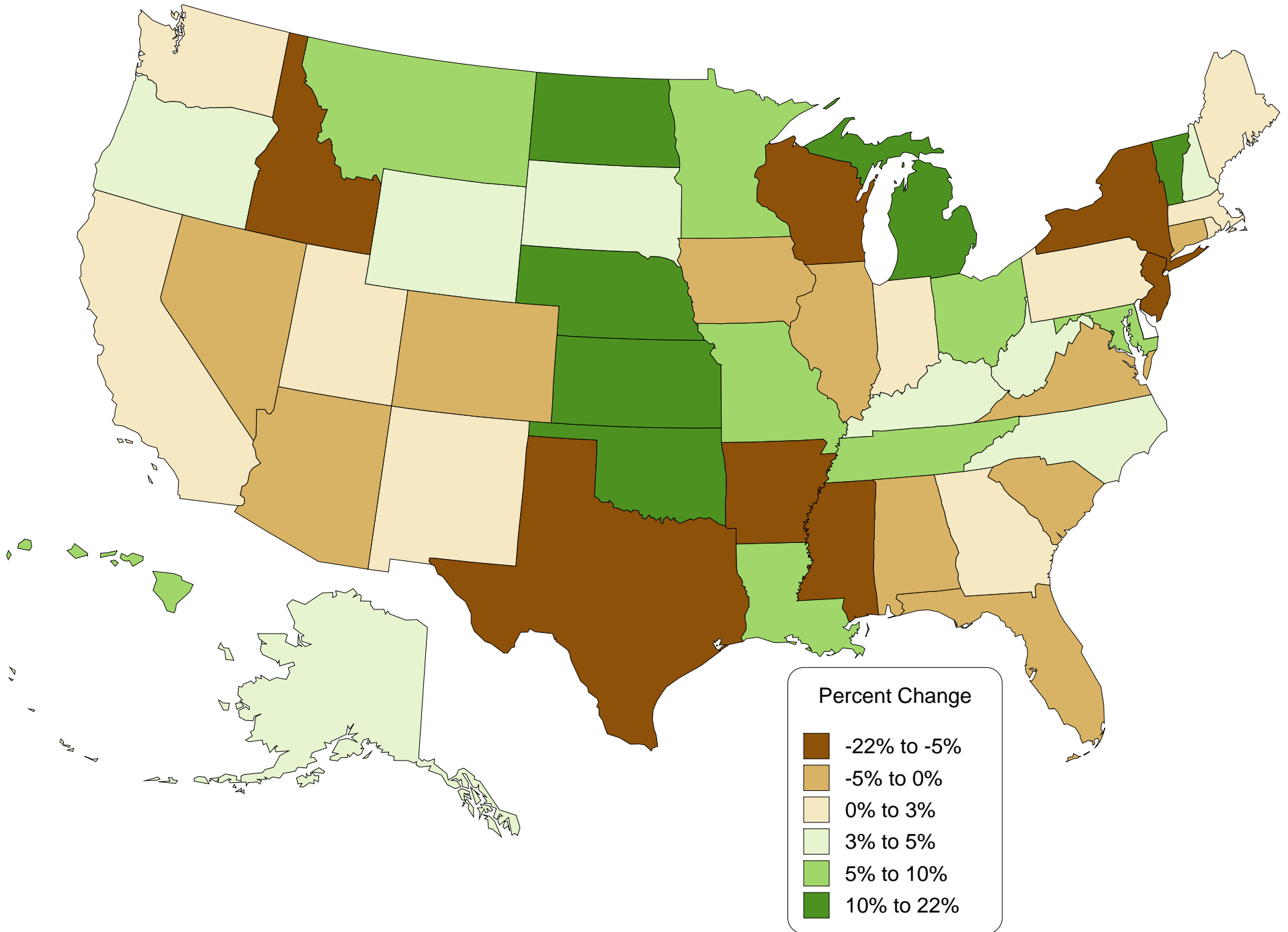
Recreation Visits by State

Table 2 reports the number of recreation visits in 2012 in NPS units in each state, the District of Columbia, and the U.S. territories of American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands. The table also shows the percent change in number of recreation visits from the previous year; Figure 2 displays this change for each state with the exception of Delaware, which does not contain an NPS unit. Overall the number of recreation visits is up 1.4 percent from 2011 (282,765,682 in 2012 compared to 278,939,216 in 2011).

Recreation Visits / Visitor Days by Region and Population Center

The next two tables show the number of recreation visits and visitor days for the seven NPS regions (Table 3) and by population center (Table 4), as well as the change from the previous year. A recreation visitor day is defined as 12 visitor hours in a park. Servicewide, recreation visits increased by 1.4 percent; recreation visitor days increased by 4.0 percent, for a total of 102,359,869 days. Figure 3 displays the recreation visits by population center for the period spanning 1990 to 2012. Population centers are defined in the Definitions section.

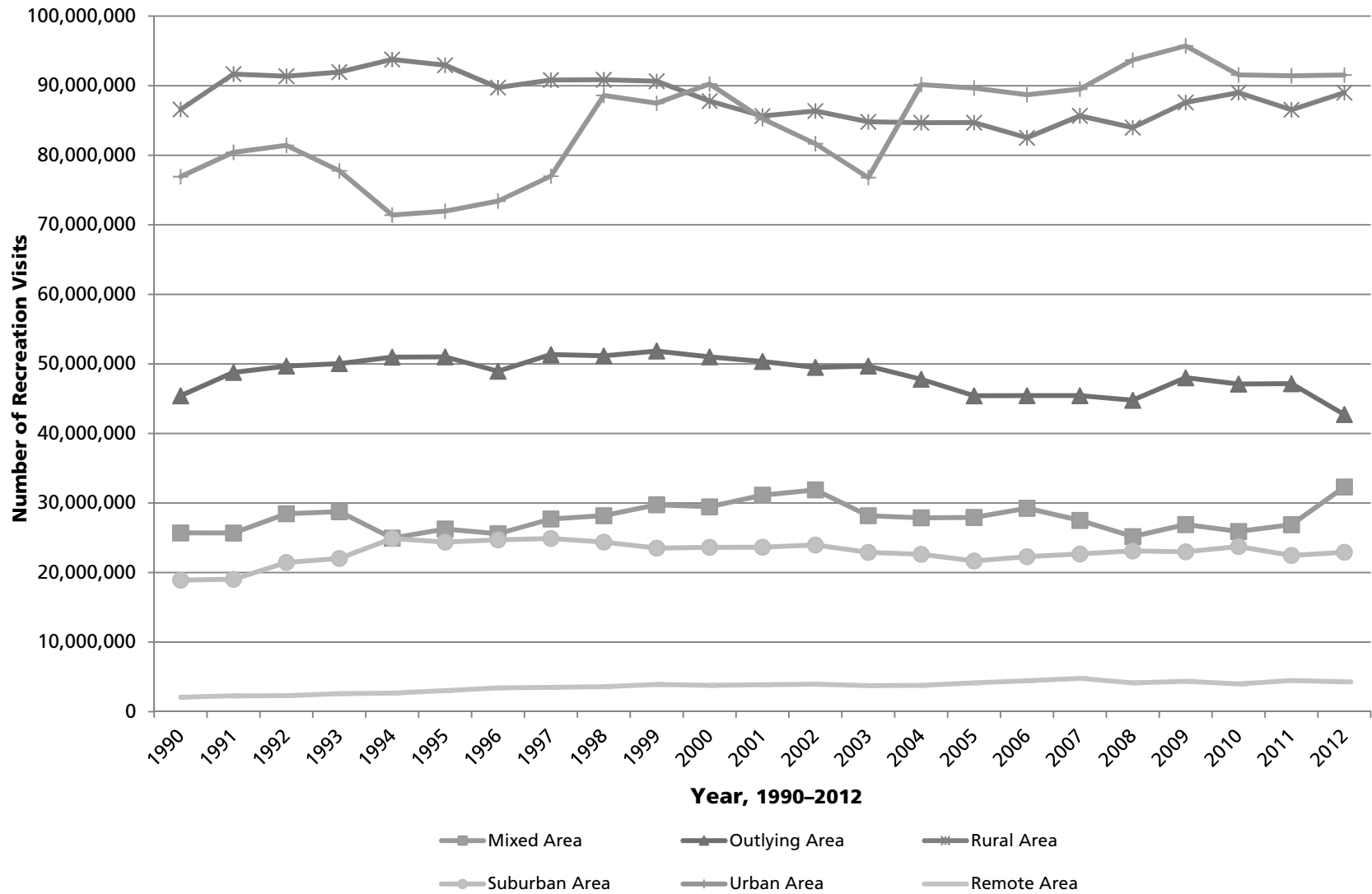

Recreation Visits and Non-Recreation Visits / Visitor Days by Park

Table 5 includes a complete record of recreation visits and visitor days for all NPS units reporting public use data. The table also shows non-recreation visits, which include through traffic (commuters), persons going to and from inholdings, trades people with business in the park, and government personnel (other than NPS employees) with business in the park. The comparison of data between 2012 and 2011 shows that, similar to the previously noted increases in recreation visits and visitor days, overall non-recreation visits and visitor days decreased.

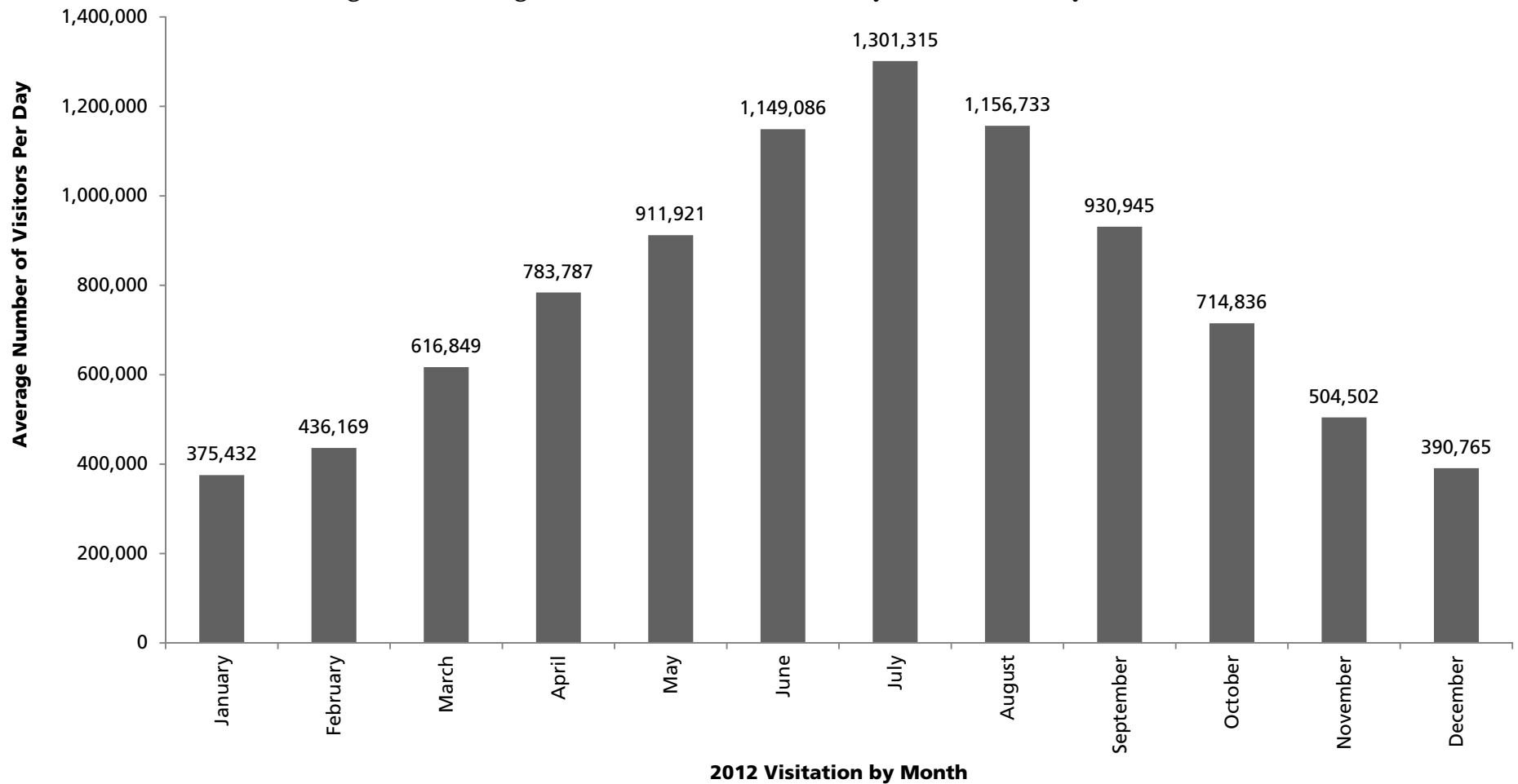

Average Visitors Per Day to NPS Units

Visitation to NPS units varies throughout the year. On a park-by-park basis, this information is important for planning purposes. The servicewide average of visitors per day, broken down by month, is shown in Figure 4. July has the highest average number per day with 1,301,315; January has the lowest with 375,432.

Overnight Stays

In addition to recreation visits, the National Park Service tracks the number of overnights stays, which are defined as one night within a park by a visitor. One visitor staying 10 nights or 10 visitors staying one night both equal 10 overnight stays. Table 6 shows the number of overnight stays by NPS unit in concessioner lodging and campgrounds and in NPS campgrounds (tent and RV spaces), backcountry, and miscellaneous locations (any other location not otherwise defined—e.g., sleeping aboard boats). The number of non-recreational overnight stays (leaseholders, line shacks for ranchers, and government personnel [other than NPS employees]) is also included. In 2012 NPS units recorded a total of 14,299,582 overnight stays in all categories which is a 2.4 percent increase over 2011. Figure 5 shows the trends for overnight stays in all categories from 1979 to 2012.

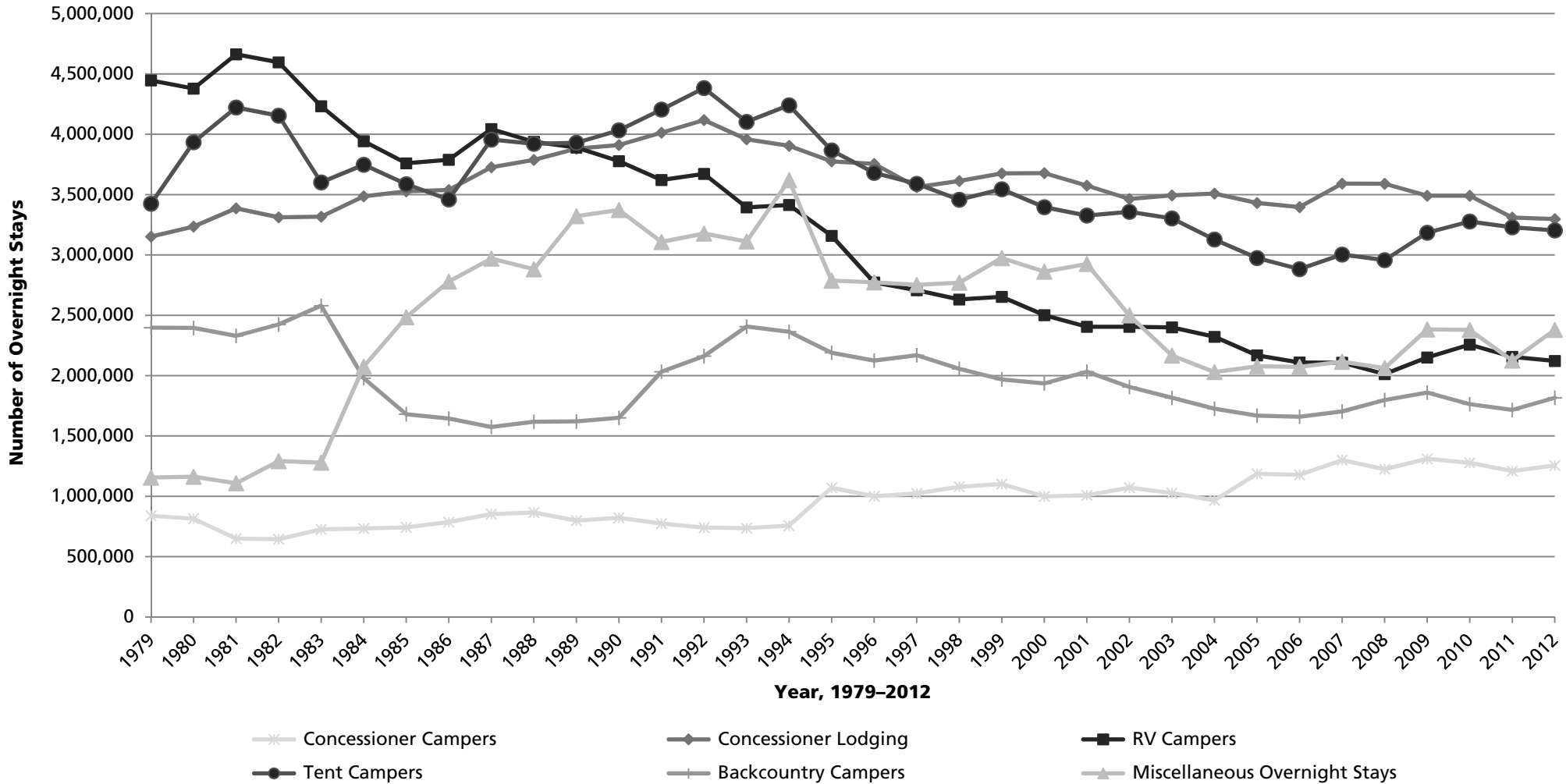

Recreation Visits/Visitor Days by State and U.S. Territory

Table 8 documents the number of recreation visits and visitor days for all NPS units that reported public use data in 2012 and displays the percent change from the previous year. Table 9 projects recreation visits for NPS units in 2013 and 2014 using 2008 - 2012 data. The forecasts are trend line extensions based on actual visitation data from the previous five years. According to the model, recreation visits are forecast to increase by 0.2 percent to 283,443,733 in 2013 and 0.3 percent to 284,362,208 in 2014.

Definitions

ACREAGE – The listings of acreage in Tables 10 and 11 use the following terms provided by the NPS Land Resources Division:

- ❑ Fee – The maximum possible estate one can possess in real property. It is the most complete and absolute ownership in land. It is of indefinite duration, freely transferable and inheritable.
- ❑ Less Than Fee – Any estate that is less than full Fee ownership, for example: Scenic Easement.
- ❑ Other Fee (Federal) – Tracts under the administration of another federal agency (e.g., U.S. Forest Service, Department of the Army, Coast Guard, etc). Bureau of Land Management tracts are also identified as Other Fee (Federal) until they are withdrawn for NPS use; then status changes to Fee (Federal).
- ❑ Public – A non-federal tract that is owned by the state, county, and/or other municipalities, including quasi-public entities such as the South Florida Water Management or the Santa Monica Conservancy.
- ❑ Private – A privately owned tract before it is acquired by the federal government. Examples of private landowners are individuals, corporations, companies, trustees, partnerships, etc.

AFFILIATED AREA – An area administrated in connection with the National Park Service (NPS), which uses NPS assistance but is neither federally owned nor directly administered by the NPS.

BACKCOUNTRY – One or more primitive or wilderness areas which are reached primarily by hiking, boating, or horseback.

CAMPGROUND – An area of land designated and developed for use as a camp.

CLASSIFICATION – Designated names for areas administered by the NPS may be found in the publication, *The National Parks: Index 2009–2011*.

CONCESSIONER – A private company or an individual granted the privilege of providing facilities and services considered necessary by the NPS for accommodating visitors.

CONCESSIONER CAMPGROUND – An element of a concessioner operation involving services for overnight camping.

CONCESSIONER LODGING – An element of a concessioner operation involving facilities for overnight lodging such as hotels, motels, cabins, cottages, trailer villages, and trailer rental.

MISCELLANEOUS OVERNIGHT STAY – Any overnight stay not otherwise defined (sleeping aboard boats, camping in organized groups, and/or any other overnight stays not included in other categories of overnight stays, except inholders, which are non-reportable).

MIXED AREA PARK – See **POPULATION CENTERS**.

NATIONAL PARK SERVICE (NPS) – A Department of the Interior (DOI) bureau which administers approximately two dozen types of federal land, nationally significant for their scenic, natural, scientific, historical, or archeological interest (see **CLASSIFICATION**). The agency was established as a Bureau of the DOI by an Act of Congress on August 25, 1916. The NPS does not administer National Forests (United States Department of Agriculture/Forest Service), Wildlife Refuges (United States Department of Interior/Fish and Wildlife Service), or a variety of other lands available for public use.

NEGLECTIBLE TRANSIT – A brief, incidental entry into a park by passing traffic (vehicular or pedestrian) using NPS-administered grounds, roads, or walkways (See **NON-REPORTABLE VISITS**).

NON-RECREATION OVERNIGHT STAY – A reportable non-recreation overnight stay includes leaseholders, line shacks for ranchers, and government personnel (other than NPS employees).

NON-RECREATION VISIT – A reportable non-recreation visit includes through traffic (commuters), persons going to and from inholdings, trades-people with business in the park, and government personnel (other than NPS employees) with business in the park.

NON-REPORTABLE VISIT – The entry into a park by NPS employees, their families, concessioner employees, members of cooperating associations, NPS contractors, and service personnel.

NOT REPORTING – These areas do not report recreation visits to the NPS.

OUTLYING AREA PARK – See **POPULATION CENTERS**.

OVERNIGHT STAY – One night within a park by a visitor.

POPULATION CENTERS – NPS areas are categorized by their proximity to population centers in the following manner:

- ❑ Mixed Area Park – A park located in a mixture of Outlying Area, Rural Area, Suburban Area, and Urban area.
- ❑ Outlying Area Park – A park located in a Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) with a population of less than one million people.
- ❑ Remote Area Park – A park located outside of any MSA and requiring special travel arrangements to reach.
- ❑ Rural Area Park – A park located outside of any MSA and accessible by paved highway, scheduled air or marine transportation service.
- ❑ Suburban Area Park – A park located outside the central city but still within a MSA with a population of greater than one million people.
- ❑ Urban Area Park – A park located within the central city of a MSA.

RECREATION VEHICLE – Any enclosed vehicle used for camping which is more elaborate than a simple truck or car, such as pickup truck with camper body, pop-up tent trailer, travel trailer, bus, motor coach, mobile home, etc.

RECREATION VISIT – The entry of a person onto lands or waters administered by the NPS for recreational purposes, excluding government personnel, through traffic (commuters), tradespeople, and people residing within park boundaries.

REGION – A NPS administrative subdivision. The seven NPS regions include the following states:

- ❑ Alaska (AK) – Alaska
- ❑ Intermountain (IM) – Arizona, Colorado, Montana, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas, Utah, Wyoming
- ❑ Midwest (MW) – Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, South Dakota, Wisconsin
- ❑ National Capital (NC) – Washington, DC, with some units in Maryland, Virginia, West Virginia
- ❑ Northeast (NE) – Connecticut, Delaware, Maryland, Massachusetts, Maine, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont, Virginia, West Virginia (excluding units assigned to National Capital Region in Maryland, Virginia and West Virginia)
- ❑ Pacific West (PW) – American Samoa, California, Guam, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Washington
- ❑ Southeast (SE) – Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Puerto Rico, South Carolina, Tennessee, U.S. Virgin Islands

REMOTE AREA PARK – See **POPULATION CENTERS**.

RURAL AREA PARK – See **POPULATION CENTERS**.

SERVICE PERSONNEL – Non-reportable visits include visits by employees of the NPS who are assigned to the park or are visiting the park in connection with their duty assignments, NPS contractors, concessioner, cooperating associations, and the temporary or permanent members in the households of NPS employees who reside in the park.

SUBURBAN AREA PARK – See **POPULATION CENTERS**.

VISIT - The entry of any person, except NPS and service personnel, onto lands or waters administered by the NPS. A visit may occur as a recreation visit or a non-recreation visit. A same-day reentry, negligible transit, and an entry to a detached portion of the same park on the same day are considered to be a single visit. Such adjustments are made insofar as practicable for noncontiguous parts of the same park. However, visits are reported separately for two contiguous parks.

VISITOR DAY - Twelve visitor hours in a park.

VISITOR HOUR - The presence of one or more persons, excluding NPS personnel, in a park for continuous, intermittent, or simultaneous periods of time aggregating one hour (e.g., one person for one hour, two persons for one-half hour).
