

A Listing of Birds, By Site, Observed in
Acadia National Park On
Interpretive Tours

Introduction

Every summer naturalists are hired to work for Acadia National Park as seasonal interpreters. One to several of these seasonal interpreters will prepare and present guided naturalist walks on birds that reside and travel through the park and area. The area is rich with many dozens of species and over 200 hundred birds have been documented as being at least seasonally resident. Many naturalists keep lists of the bird as well as other species of animals that they observe to share with visitors and other staff members. Often these lists are kept in little field books by each interpreter and never documented in a formal report for many reasons.

Methods

From June 12, 2005 until October 15, 2005, interpretive rangers Lora Haller, Carrie Karl, and Jennifer Schramm observed and noted various bird species in the park. All three rangers are birders and can easily identify all species noted. A tally sheet was kept in the interpretive office and rangers would mark the sheet weekly. Observations of birds would typically occur while on duty at the Precipice for the peregrine falcon program, Hawkwatch on Cadillac Mountain, bird walks with visitors at various locations in the park, and while walking or hiking in the park at all other times. Birds were identified by sound, sight, or both at the noted locations. The noted birds for a site does not represent a comprehensive list of the birds species that might be found at these locations as would be expected with full field inventory or monitoring program, but instead reflects those birds that were identified by week and throughout the season through a casual or general method of bird observation. The bird list was intended and did serve as list of current species being seen in different areas of the park as a reference for all staff, but especially for the "non-birding" staff who were working at the visitor centers. It also serve in a similar way to inform visitors interested in "birding" about what they might see, where to go, what they may find, and to aid them in finding or identifying specific species. The weekly tally sheets were maintained throughout the 2006 visitor season and the information was then entered into a spreadsheet in mid-October.

Results

Attached is the spreadsheet of birds observed and recorded by the authors. Many bird species were seen on numerous occasions and for several weeks over the course of the summer and fall. We did not record if a bird species was observed more than once during a week, although a few exceptions are noted on the spreadsheet for species like crows, American robin, and a few species of warblers. The spreadsheet file will be maintained by the Interpretive Staff.

Discussion

The weekly tally sheets and overall bird list successfully served to inform park staff and volunteers of the birds that were most likely to be seen or heard in different locations within the park. Maintaining an active bird list helps staffs who only work at one location or in one part of the park by giving them a readily available reference on birds. The weekly tally also provided information important to visitors who have a special interest in birding while visiting Acadia National Park and areas in and around the Mount Desert Island.
