

FORT WASHINGTON PARK

VISITOR USE REPORTING AND COUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

Following are detailed instructions for collecting data and estimating visitor use statistics for **Fort Washington Park**. These instructions are effective the date of issuance and will continue in effect unless changed by agreement between the NPS Social Science Program and the Park Superintendent.

Recreation Visits

1. A pneumatic tube traffic counter is located on the entrance lane to the park. The traffic count is multiplied by the persons-per-vehicle multiplier in Table 1.
2. The number of walk-in visitors.
3. A pneumatic tube traffic counter is located across the entrance road to Fort Foote. The traffic count is divided by two to account for entry and exit. The adjusted traffic is multiplied by the persons-per-vehicle multiplier in Table 1.

Recreation Visitor Hours

The total number of recreation visitors is multiplied by three hours (January, February, November, and December) or four hours (March through October)
